

**POLICY TYPE: GOVERNANCE PROCESS**  
**POLICY TITLE: BOARD OFFICERS**

---

**GP-L2c** The Board shall have four officers, President, Vice-President, Secretary and Treasurer. The officers will be selected by Board vote following each general election. Secretary and Treasurer may be the same person. **President, Vice-President shall serve 2 year terms pursuant to CRS 22-32-104.**

**GP-L3c** The President of the Board ensures the integrity of the Board's processes and serves as the Board's official spokesperson.

1. the President has the following authority and duties:
  - A. make all interpretive decisions that fall within the topics covered by Board policies on *Governance Process* and *Board – Superintendent Relationships*, except where the Board specifically delegates portions of this authority to others, using any reasonable interpretations of the provisions in those policies.
  - B. meeting discussion content will be on those issues which, according to Board policy clearly belong to the Board to decide or to monitor.
  - C. refrain from making any interpretive decisions about policies created by the Board in the Ends and Operational Limitations policy areas.
  - D. refrain from exercising any authority as an individual to supervise or direct the Superintendent.
  - E. ensure that deliberation is fair, open and thorough, but also timely, orderly, and kept to the point.
2. other officers:
  - A. the vice-president shall assume the role of the President in the absence of the President.
  - B. the Secretary/Treasurer shall ensure the integrity of Board documents and records.
