



Park County Ski/SB Lessons

Learn at Breckenridge Ski & Snowboard School



Program Details

Who: Park County Re-2 students *ages 6 or over and under 14* by the start date of **January 10, 2019**

Dates: Fridays: Jan 10, 17, 24, 31 Feb 7, (NO 14th) 21, 28, and March 6

Times: 9 am- 11:30 am Lesson Noon- 1:45 pm free skiing/riding with chaperones (on gondola down by 2pm)
(*Breckenridge is not responsible or liable once the lesson is over at 11:30am*)

*If riding bus from **Lake George** 6am pick-up and ~4pm drop off at school, From **Fairplay** 7:30am depart- 3pm return

Cost: \$311 \$195 to Breck, \$116 to Park County Schools ~includes lift tickets and gear use (no food, pack sack lunch)

Equipment: Provided by the district. Kids should show up appropriately dressed and ready to go. *Helmets required!*

Drop Off: Students and Chaperones will meet Instructors at the base of Peak 8 (where gondola drops off) at 8:45 am. Students can either ride the bus to the gondola or have parents drop them off.

Registration

- Students must be registered and paid with Breck Ski School by **Dec 1st, 2019**.
- Parents will register their child by reading the information and filling out all required paperwork at: <https://forms.gle/jKDhibXXqap9teEf6> (This Google form **must** be filled out and confirmed before calling Breckenridge for payment)
- The **first** payment of \$195 must be made by credit card directly to Breckenridge by calling 1-888-576-2754.
- The **second** payment of \$116 per child will be paid to Park County School District (PCSD) by check and **must** be paid by **Jan 10th**.
**If your child fundraised you will be contacted about the available funds to apply to the program.*
- Parents must sign the *ROL for Resort Activities* for each child prior to start of program. Once you complete the [google form](#), you will receive the **waiver** to sign.

Lessons

- Students can borrow gear/equipment for the season. Gear check out date: **Dec. 6th** *details will be given after registration.
- Kids will be given an 8-day Program lift ticket that can only be used on lesson days.
 - Attach to jacket and bring every week (do not wash or remove lift ticket!)
- Classes will work on appropriate skills for the group, students will stay with their group for all 8 sessions.

Chaperones

- We will have a 6:1 child to chaperone ratio.
- Please signify on *google form* if you can chaperone.
- We will need chaperones to commit to the majority of the 8 sessions. Also we will need chaperones both in the lodge and with the lesson groups.
- Chaperones are responsible for groups throughout the season and we cannot participate in lessons and subsequently free ski time without required number of adults. Chaperones **MUST** always be with a group or in the ski school area.

Alpine Skiing or Snowboarding

The Winter Activities program includes eight skiing and snowboarding lessons and free ski/ride on Breckenridge's Peak 8 Mountain! No prior experience is necessary. This program is available to all Park County Re-2 students in grades 2 – 8.

This program includes eight Friday sessions, transportation, and equipment (if needed). The Program starts in January and ends in March 6th. Note there is no program Presidents' Day weekend, Friday February 14th. Program dates, Fridays: Jan 10, 17, 24, 31 Feb 7, (NO 14th) 21, 28, and March 6. Attendance is required for the first class. Additionally if multiple days are missed student may have to join lessons with a lower level group. Of course, there may be a day when your student is unable to attend, but to get the most out of the program, it is best to try to make it for all sessions. Missed lessons will not be refunded. Breckenridge Ski and Ride School states that this program is meant to be a "learn-to" program and encourages accomplished skiers and riders to try different recreational avenues if they are beyond lessons.

The school district is limiting total enrollment to the first 60 participants due to transportation constraints. Complete applications will be given first priority.

The total cost for the program includes: transportation, 8 lessons-2.5 hours each, 1+ hr of supervised free time on the mountain, alpine skis or snowboards and a helmet from the school and lift tickets for all lesson days is \$311. The lessons are taught by professional instructors at Breckenridge, and the supervised time on the mountain is done by parent volunteers. On that note, we welcome parents of all abilities to join us (chaperones MUST pass a background check with the school and have finger prints on file prior). See the registration form to sign up as a chaperone. ONLY those who fill out ALL the information for chaperones will be considered. Priority will be given to those who are able to attend all sessions.

There is the potential for injuries, therefore we require all participants to wear a helmet at all times on the mountain. Not only will the helmet help protect your student, it's a great way to keep warm. We have helmets of all sizes that can be borrowed for the season. If a student forgets any of their gear they will not be able to participate. Please understand your child's safety is our primary concern, and help us by respecting the helmet requirement.

The general schedule for each week is as follows:

- 6:00 A.M. Bus leaves LGCS **SHARP** 6:20 A.M. Bus pick up at CR23 6:30 A.M. Bus pick up at Badger Basin in Hartsel
- 7:00–7:25 A.M. Students check pick up gear at Sports Complex building and load the buses.
- 7:25-7:30 A.M. Quick roll call, bus leaves at 7:35 A.M. SHARP
- 9:00 A.M. - 11:30 A.M. The instructors will greet us (8:45am) at the hill and take students off to lessons.
- 11:30 A.M. – 1:55 P.M. Parent volunteers will supervise students for lunch (student brings sack lunch or money to purchase food) at One Ski Hill Place Restaurant, have free time on the mountain, and supervise children on the gondola down to the bus.
- 2:05 P.M. Everyone needs to be back on the bus for roll call. 2:15 P.M. Bus Leaves Breckenridge
- 3:00 P.M. Bus arrives in Fairplay 3:30 P.M. Bus arrives in Hartsel 3:40 P.M. Bus arrives in CR23
- 4:00 P.M. Bus arrives in Lake George *once registered you will be sent information to be notified of weather delays or cancellations via *Remind* app.
